



Ethical Judgement and Integrity: Case Study

An actuarial team at an African insurance company, while developing a health insurance product for low- and middle-income markets, found that traditional risk-based pricing would result in high premiums for vulnerable groups, making insurance unaffordable for them.

This raised an ethical dilemma: whether to prioritize financial accuracy or subsidize premiums to increase access, despite potential financial risks.




